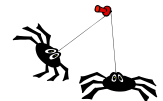

Call Completion Issues?



There is a serious problem with call completion throughout America's telecom network, yet to date, the FCC has appeared uninterested in addressing this issue. As you may have experienced, the problem manifests itself with long distance call set up times, the calling party hearing dead air, the called party picking up and hearing dead air, poor call quality, or one party being able to hear and not the other. This issue referred to by the telephone industry as a "call termination" or "least cost routing" is a national problem affecting most rural Telephone companies, all who have provided detailed documentation to the FCC. The problem arises as a result of originating long distance carrier transporting the call, generally through an intermediated carrier. In most cases, we've found that the intermediate carrier doesn't properly route the call with the required information or doesn't pass the call at all. In all cases Lincoln Telephone has investigated, the data necessary for us to complete the call is not received. Therefore, unfortunately, there is nothing we can do to resolve the problem. Lincoln Telephone is frustrated, as we know you are with these long distance carriers! We encourage you to file a complaint with the FCC at 1-888-225-5322 or www.fcc.gov/complaints.
